



Most Commonly Asked Questions From The Industry About Filming at the BC Museum of Mining

- **Do you have a contact list of all landowners in Britannia?** *Yes, we also have it in our comprehensive package which includes names of experienced local residents used as PA's, as well as a local extras casting company, retail shopkeepers, accommodation, food vendors & more.*
- **Can flexible-filming times be arranged to access site?** *Yes, we have experienced Liaisons available.*
- **Do we need a Liaison?** *Only if the requirements of the film warrant having a liaison. Some situations may be; if the production should go outside of our business hours, if a heritage building is being used, if it's an area that is governed under the Mining Act or if the type of activity requires a liaison there.*
- **Availability of Parking?** *We have designated parking areas close to key film sites for Circuses and Crew Park. There is also parking available from the other landholders as noted on the contact hand out sheet and our site map.*
- **Do we guarantee the weather?** *No, sorry, there is no limiting the realm of possibilities, but generally because we are at sea level, snow is never really an issue.*
- **Are there washroom facilities available?** *As we are a Museum first and foremost, we need to make sure that our patrons needs are met at the highest quality of service, therefore we request that you bring in your own Portable Washroom units. We do however, offer suitable sites to place them on.*
- **Is power available?** *Yes, in most cases, we also work with a local electrical company who holds the permits for the area if temporary removal is required.*
- **Do we offer competitive pricing?** *Yes, we are in close communication with other Museum facilities and have honored the 10% fee reduction as per the BC Film Forum – Nov 17, 2003. We are also a not for profit organization so our fees are very reasonable. We enjoy a close working relationship with Location Managers to create clear communication lines for a successful conclusion.*
- **Being a Museum, does that impact on what we can do in and around the buildings?** *Yes, but we will work with you to try to achieve your goals.*

4 Easy Steps to Filming at the BC Museum of Mining

1. Call and make an appointment for a site visit time.
2. Fill out the Application Form, (as follows) and return with the Application Fee of \$107.00 (tax included) - cheques made out to the 'BC Museum of Mining'.
3. Staff will call to go over the details and set up a working contract for signature from the Producer.
4. The signed Site License Agreement is returned with payment for 'estimated costs' and agreement to pay any Additional Charges for Special Services before wrap is completed is authorized by the Producer.
